Can We Trust the Bible?

Proving the Bible has not been corrupted since it was written. Part 1

1. How do we know that most of the New Testament documents were written before 70 AD?
2. What big event happened in 70 AD that is not in any of the New Testament documents?
3. How many copies and fragments of the New Testament have we found?
4. How many of those are in the original Greek?
5. Are the Greek copies identical?
6. How different are the copies from each other when we remove typos and technical errors?
7. If the copies only differ by that amount from each other, how accurate are we to the original? Why?
8. Could Constantine have changed all the manuscripts to indicate Jesus was God? Why not?
9. Is the Bible like the Koran or the Book of Mormon, where we have no idea where it came from or nothing in it matches archeology or history? Why or why not?
10. Is it just a book of legends and fables that have been changed over time by people who want to manipulate and control us?
