7. How do you handle the Christian dilemma of balancing truth and love when interfacing with the watching world?
8. In what ways do you think Christians fall short at showing love (as defined by Paul)?
9. In what ways do you think Christians excel in showing love (as defined by Paul)?
10. Who/how/when would you challenge yourself to show love to someone this week?
