7. Why do you think some Christians fall prey to the temptation to speak the language of judgment or fear? What does that say about their view of God?
8. What are some practical ways you can balance grace/truth to speak the language of reconciliation to a hurting world?
9. What are your hopes and dreams for SFC?
10. What do you think is holding us back from those dreams?
