God Uncensored: What Do I Do Now?
Mark 5:21-43

1. What was your life like 10 years ago? A decade can go by so quickly. Tells some stories about your family, job, living situation, etc. What is the thing you miss the most about that time? What is the thing you miss the least?
2. When you think about the past and the future, how does it make you feel? Which one do you struggle with the most—your past or your future? How often are you able to celebrate the past versus thinking about the pain of your past? How often are you able to dream about the future without being worried or fearful of what will happen?
3. In the story this week, and the last two weeks, fear has been a theme. How do you deal with fear in your life? Is there something that you wish you didn't fear?
4. Who do you relate to most in the story this week—the woman or the ruler? Or maybe you relate to the disciples in week one or the man in week two of this series.
5. Another theme in all of these narratives is that people cry out to Jesus. Is there something that you are asking Jesus for these days?

Pray together about these things.
