Luke 4:16-30

1. When you were young, what are some of the professions that you thought you might pursue? Why? When you look back on your life, are there any “turns” (opportunities that you had to go in a better direction) that you missed?
2. Paul said, “...the kingdom of God is not a matter of talk but of power.” (1 Corinthians 4:20). Where do you need power in your life?
3. Jesus went home. How is “going home” for you? What sorts of things happen for you emotionally when you go back to where you grew up, went to school, see old friends or places? Maybe you’ve lived in the same area for a long time. Open an old yearbook or think about how you feel about your younger years. Share. What do you think Jesus was feeling when He went home?
4. Why do you think Jesus stops quoting Isaiah when He does? Why is Jesus offensive to the people? Why do you think the people got so angry?
5. How do you handle disappointment? Are there any dreams that you have had that have died? How can we learn to dream again?
6. What is the biggest lesson for you personally from Luke 4:14-30? What’s the biggest lesson for you from the whole series, God Uncensored?
