What did you think of the photo of the “Migrant Mother”? Sometimes, when we see an artist’s depiction of Ruth or Naomi, it’s a little too glamorous (think Hollywood). How might it help, in our Biblical understanding, to see things differently?

If you are a woman, how does it make you feel that the options for women in the ancient culture were so limited? What kinds of progress, for women, do we still need to make as Christians? As a culture?

What else from the message hit you this week? Where could you use more power or encouragement in your life?

What would “finding home” mean to you?
