- Write down 3 words that you would use to describe the mother figure in your life.

What do you think about God describing himself in motherly terms? How does this help us honor motherhood and women?

Which of the 3 ways of being generous with honor resonated with you the most? We see the Gospel story in Ruth. What part of this story speaks to you most?

Ruth is an ancient story. Consider the plight of these women and the challenges they faced because of the ancient culture they lived in (safety, Ruth on the threshing floor, having to be redeemed by a man, etc.), even among "God's people."
