4. What do you worry about?

6. What does the “desire to be rich” and the “love of money” look like? How do we hide it?
7. How does the love of money and desire to be rich plunge us into snares/problems? Give some examples.
8. Why do you think true life (v.19) is found in being generous?
9. What motivates you to be generous? What keeps you from being generous?
10. Challenge: if we surveyed your bank account, what would we surmise about what you value? What would we surmise about your contentment?
